SEMESTER 1 REPORTS

Next week your child's semester one report will be sent home. This document aims to provide you with information on your child's progress this semester. Please be aware that content taught this semester is different from what your child was taught last semester hence it is not advisable to try and compare this report against previous documents.

It is also important to remember that children develop differently. Often parents of young babies fall into the trap of comparing their child's development with the milestones of other babies and toddlers, please remember this is a report on your child and should not be compared to reports of other children. Teaching staff have decided to include some standardised test and in class assessments results to provide parents with a more comprehensive picture of their child's progress. It is not advisable to compare scores with those of other students.

Parents are welcome to make an appointment to look at student work samples and data.

Please note student attendance data is also included in your child's report. Next semester partial absences and late arrivals will be included in the reports.

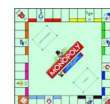
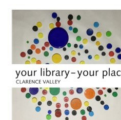
