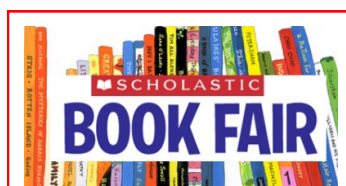
SOUTH GRAFTON HIGH CSI PROGRAM FOR 2017

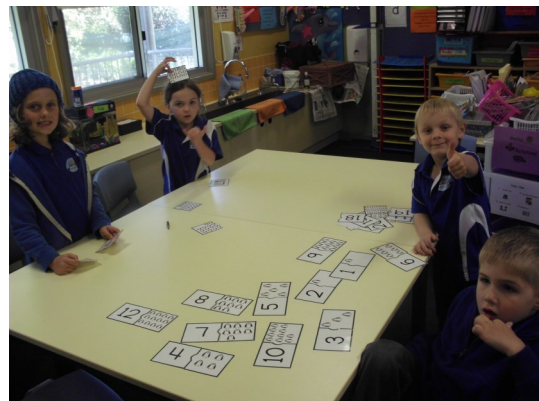

K/1 Science

In our third lesson, the K/1 class were Ant Explorers! We recorded what they think they knew about ants, observed and drew ants in their natural habitat and tracked their movements and observed and record information about ants.

2/3 Science

2/3 is continuing to learn how to classify animals and work in collaborative learning teams. In our last lesson we identified different features that may be useful for identifying animals, discussed how to identify animals using their features by playing a game of 'What am I?' and worked in teams to identify features shared by at least three animals using a T-chart.

4/5/6 Science

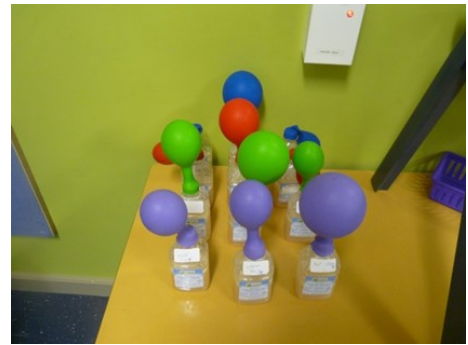
4/5/6 continued their third lesson in their "Marvellous micro-organisms" unit. In lesson two, students learned what happened when yeast was mixed with sugar and water (carbon dioxide is created). In this lesson they experimented to find out what temperature is best for this reaction to occur. We experimented with cold water, warm water and hot water and discovered that overall, warm water, sugar and yeast produced the most carbon dioxide (as shown in the photos below). Next lesson we will be making bread!

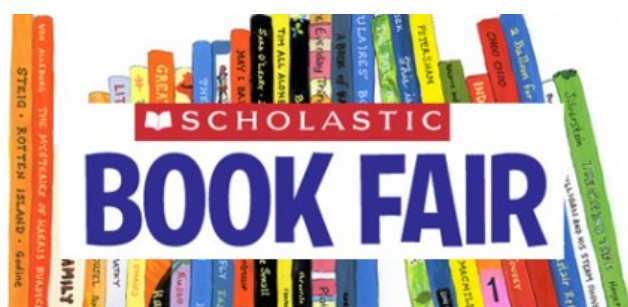
