We have started our NAIDOC Day celebrations early learning about Aboriginal Dot Art and designing our own creations.

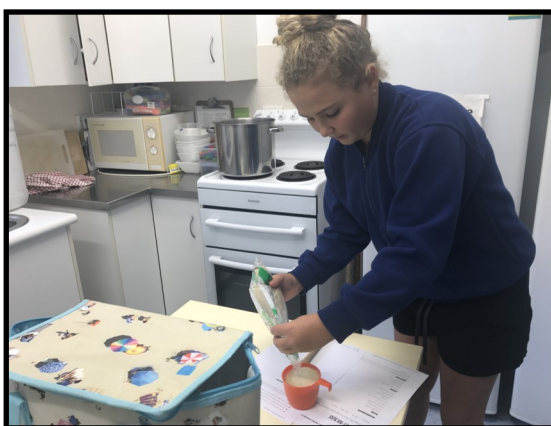
