Congratulations to all our competitors and I know you will proudly represent our school at the next level. Well done everyone.

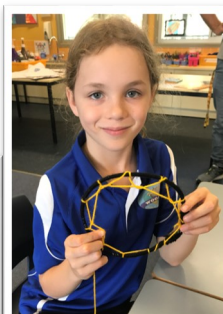
